Message from the President, Patrick Sieg

Dear Rockville Art League artists,

A very big thank you to all members who took a chance by entering our juried show. The entries were both beautiful and record setting in number.

When we have such a response then we will have both a strong show and difficult choices. The Glenview Mansion Art Gallery will accommodate about 115 artworks, and, with the help of our judge, we need to cap our selections to fit the space.

RAL is lucky to have judge Zdeno Mayercak to make those difficult choices and the show that he has compiled is excellent and will prove to be among our best.

His next step will be deciding which selected work will be further recognized with an award and will be finalized in person on November 29th.

Zdeno will also meet with members in person at Glenview Mansion for a walk through of our show on December 8th beginning at 6:30 pm.

Our members are remarkable artists and, as is always the case for juried shows, some work must be excluded. Those choices are not a commentary on the work but rather the judge's vision for the entire show.

Perhaps, sometime in the future, we could consider an exhibit comprised of work juried out of a RAL or other juried show. Think about the *Salon de Refuses* in 19th century Paris when Manet, Cezanne, Whistler, Courbet, and others pooled their work that had been excluded from the Paris Salon Show for an exhibit that created and art movement and was the beginning of Impressionism.

Immediately following our winter show, Glenview will host the annual Rockville Student Juried Art Show.

In recent years the student show has occupied two rooms in the gallery and this gives RAL an opportunity to show additional member work. We will need approximately 70 pieces to supplement the student show and members may submit one or two entries for a show in conjunction with the student show. The name of this show is "Heart of Winter."

The final number of pieces we can accommodate will depend on the number of student entries that are accepted. Please see the show call that is included in this newsletter.

In early November the Glen Echo Resident
Artist and art educator J. Jordan Bruns shared
how his three years in Japan has influenced his
art practice. We recorded his Zoom
presentation, and it is still available for viewing.
Please treat yourself and view this recording.
Jordan is an amazingly talented artist and a fine
speaker. And if you saw the presentation in
"real time" it is worth seeing a second time.

In February RAL will host RAL member, Compass Atelier leader and noted artist Glen Kessler who will demonstrate the art of portraiture.

The days are shorter now and perhaps the colder weather keeps us indoors. I hope you have a warm and comfortable studio that will inspire you and facilitate the creation of new art and or give you the opportunity to appreciate another artist's craft and vision.

I am fortunate to be a part of our Rockville Art League, to know so many wonderful artists and hope you will enjoy the upcoming holidays (and each other) to the fullest. Happy Thanksgiving, be well and stay warm.

- TUESDAY, November 29, 10:00am-1:00pm, delivery of artwork. You or your designee must deliver your work on this date. No late entries will be accepted. The judge will assign awards based on an in-person review of the works on this date.
- Sunday, December 4, 1:30-3:30pm: please join us to "Meet the Artists" and see the show. EVERYONE is welcome! Awards at 2:00pm.
- Thursday, December 8, 6:30-8:00pm: judge Zdeno Mayercak will lead a gallery walk through at Glenview. A pre-recoded video of Zdeno Mayercak discussing the award-winning pieces will also be mailed out to all members.
- <u>TUESDAY</u>, January 17, 10:00am-1:00pm, pick up artwork.

A virtual version of this show will be available to view and share prior to the opening.

Glenview Mansion Art Gallery is located on the 2nd floor of Glenview Mansion at the Rockville Civic Center Park, **603 Edmonston**Drive in Rockville. The second floor is accessible by stairs and an elevator. There is plenty of parking in the lot below and accessible parking near the back entrance. There is still time to see this beautiful show *Alone, Together*: The pandemic shook humanity to its core. We were required to distance ourselves from each other to survive; we learned to work from home; shop from home; shun each other. Mortality loomed large as the virus raged respecting no borders, class, creed, nor gender. We lived in fear as the corona virus threatened to engulf the world with its ferocity, revealing deep disparities within societies. We mourned the loss of family members, friends, nurses, doctors, and other essential workers. And yet, we transcended this global threat with the miracle of scientific innovations, and the loneliness and loss with the strength of deep human bonds within families, communities, countries, and the earth. We were physically alone, but spiritually together. In this exhibit, we explore the subject of companionship in solitude.

The exhibit is free and open to the public. There is plenty of parking and the gallery is wheelchair accessible.


Glenview is open weekdays Monday – Friday, 9:00am-4:30pm.



Rockville Art League HEART OF WINTER

January 22 – February 17, 2023 Glenview Mansion

Call for entries: <u>December 1 – December 30</u>, online

submissions only

Rockville Art League members *in good standing* are invited to submit original works *up to two* (2) *pieces of art for consideration* for the show *Heart of Winter* to be exhibited at the Glenview Mansion Art Gallery. This show is sponsored by the Rockville Art League and the City of Rockville Arts Division.

"In the depth of winter, I finally learned that within me there lay an invincible summer." Albert Camus

We are looking for your interpretations that portray winter – the beauty in bleakness, the branches, the underbrush, the wildlife, dramatic shadows, the unique atmosphere, a wintry scene, outdoors, indoors, a cozy chair in a sunny spot or by the fire, dreaming of summer, uplifted by a bouquet of flowers or a winter garden. Or perhaps you head to a warmer locale, "the winter of discontent, made into a glorious summer....

This show *Heart of Winter* will be on display in conjunction with the *Rockville Student Juried Art Show* at Glenview.

Due to space limitations, we can accept only a certain number of pieces. Interested members may enter up to 2 pieces for consideration.

Original artwork only may be submitted in the following categories of artwork:

- oils/acrylics
- watercolors
- drawings, pastels, hand-pulled prints

- mixed media, collage, experimental
- photography
- sculpture
- Note: for this show the work may have been exhibited in a prior show and acceptance in this show does not preclude its entry in a future show.

All 2-D pieces will need to be framed, gallery-wrapped or professionally finished, securely wired, ready for hanging with the *maximum* measurement of any framed side of 48 inches. If submitting unframed work, the edges should be painted or finished. No wet paint. Entries not meeting the show conditions will not be accepted. RAL retains the right to determine the suitability of the work for entry in this show.

TO ENTER: please use *your same personal link and password* that was sent to you to enter your work for the *RAL Juried Members' Winter Show*.

When you submit work, you will need to complete the following for each of your pieces (up to 2 entries only): 1.) title 2.) medium 3.) market price (not wholesale!) (If NFS, please leave blank and we will confirm with you), 4.) a clear image (jpg.) of your artwork, and 5.) dimensions (for 2-D artwork - height and width only; depth is for sculpture only).

<u>Note</u>: When you submit work, *if you entered artwork in the past several RAL Shows*, you may see the images of those pieces. They are marked appropriately for those shows within the system.

Show agreement: you will need to agree to the following *before your work can be exhibited at Glenview*. Please do so once notifications are sent out.

"I agree to the exhibition dates as listed below, that my entries are my original works, and I will not hold the Rockville Art League (RAL), Glenview Mansion, Glenview Mansion Art Gallery, or the City of Rockville responsible for any possible loss or damage to my entries while on the Rockville Civic Center Park property. I understand that all reasonable care will be taken in handling my entries. I give RAL, Glenview Mansion, and the City of Rockville permission to photograph my artwork and publish them as appropriate. I acknowledge a commitment to donate 20% of the sale price of my work, if sold during this show at Glenview to the City of Rockville."




