4 items of importance to complete PRIOR to delivery of artwork:

1. **By entering work into the *RAL Juried Members' Winter Show*, you have agreed to the terms of the SHOW AGREEMENT listed here (and listed in the show call). Please reread it here:**

"I agree to the exhibition dates as listed in the schedule, that my entries are my original works, and I will not hold the Rockville Art League (RAL), Glenview Mansion, or the City of Rockville responsible for any possible loss or damage to my entries while on the property. I understand that all reasonable care will be taken in handling my entries. I give RAL, Glenview Mansion, and the City of Rockville permission to photograph my artwork and publish it as appropriate. I acknowledge a commitment to donate 20% of the sale price of my work, if sold during this show at Glenview, to the City of Rockville."

2. **All 2-dimensional work must be framed, gallery wrapped or professionally finished, securely wired with hanging wire. (No loops, sawtooth hangers, etc.)** If submitting unframed canvas, *edges must be painted or finished*. NO WET canvases allowed. Please take care of this important display step NOW. All **accepted work must be delivered on Tuesday, Nov. 28, 10:00am-1:00pm** to be included in the show.

3. **There is a \$10 SHOW FEE**, per accepted artist (not per piece). You may pay this on <http://www.rockvilleartleague.org> by clicking on the show fee button. Please do so by **FRIDAY, Nov. 17.**

4. **ANY CHANGES to your label information PLEASE send BY FRIDAY, NOV. 17.**

**Schedule:**

- **FRIDAY, Nov. 17:** \$10 show fee paid (per accepted artist, not per piece), and any changes to label information by this date.
- **TUESDAY, Nov. 28, 10:00am-1:00pm,** delivery of artwork. You or your designee must deliver your work on this date. No late entries will be accepted. The judge will assign awards based on an in-person review of the works on this date.
- **Sunday, Dec. 3, 1:30-3:30pm:** please join us to **“Meet the Artists”** and see the show. Invite your friends, family, neighbors, etc. Judge Palden Hamilton will **award prizes at 2:00pm.** He will be available throughout the afternoon to talk with artists.
- **The week of Dec. 4:** A pre-recorded video of Palden Hamilton discussing the award-winning pieces will also be sent out to all members.
- **TUESDAY, Jan. 16, 10:00am-1:00pm,** pick up of artwork. You or your designee **MUST** pick up your work on this date.

A virtual version of this show will be available to view and share prior to the opening.

**Glenview Mansion Art Gallery** is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Glenview Mansion at the Rockville Civic Center Park, **603 Edmonston Drive in Rockville.** The second floor is accessible by stairs and there is ***an ELEVATOR to all levels of the gallery.*** There is plenty of parking in the lot below and accessible parking near the back entrance.
