3 items of importance:

1. **By entering work into this show, you have agreed to the terms of the show agreement that were included in the call of entries and are listed below.**  
**PLEASE REREAD THEM:** "I agree to the exhibition dates as listed in the schedule, that my entries are my original works, and I will not hold the Rockville Art League (RAL), Glenview Mansion, or the City of Rockville responsible for any possible loss or damage to my entries while on the property. I understand that all reasonable care will be taken in handling my entries. I give RAL, Glenview Mansion, and the City of Rockville permission to photograph my artwork and publish it as appropriate. I acknowledge a commitment to donate 20% of the sale price of my work, if sold during this show at Glenview, to the City of Rockville."
2. **All 2-dimensional work** *must be framed, gallery wrapped or professionally finished*, securely wired with hanging wire. (No loops, sawtooth hangers, etc.) If submitting unframed canvas, *edges must be painted or finished*. **No wet canvases allowed**. Please take care of this important display task now. All **accepted** work *must be exhibition ready and delivered on TUESDAY, Jan. 20, 10:00am-1:00pm* to be included in the show.
3. **Any changes to label information**, please send **no later than Monday, Jan. 12**. Contact info below.
4. THERE IS **NO SHOW FEE** for this show.

**SCHEDULE:** PLEASE MARK these important dates on your calendar NOW!

**Exhibition dates: Jan. 25 – Feb. 13** \*These are the dates the show is on display to the public. We ask that work remain on display until the pick-up date of Feb. 17.

**MONDAY, Jan. 12:** any changes to label information, please send by this date.

**TUESDAY, Jan. 20:** drop off artwork at Glenview Mansion, **10:00am-1:00pm**. (It is the SAME date/time as artwork pick-up of *RAL Juried Members' Winter Show*). The judge will review the work in person that afternoon.

**SUNDAY, Jan. 25:** Meet the Artists Opening at Glenview. 1:30-3:30pm. Awards at 2pm.

**TUESDAY, Feb. 17:** pick-up of artwork 10:00am-1:00pm.

We are honored to have **Erin Raedeke** award prizes of recognition for the ***Seeing Red*** show. Awards will be **presented beginning at 2:00pm in person at Glenview Mansion on Jan. 25, immediately following the presentation of certificates to the Rockville Student Artists**. Her remarks will be posted on the virtual show the week after the opening. A virtual show will be mailed out to members and available on the website.

**Glenview Mansion Art Gallery** is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Glenview Mansion at the Rockville Civic Center Park, **603 Edmonston Drive in Rockville**. The second floor is accessible by stairs and an elevator to all levels of the gallery. There is plenty of parking in the lot below and accessible parking near the back entrance.
